

- FOR YOUR SAFETY -

- ✓ Damaging natural gas facilities is dangerous to both the contractor and to the FNG and emergency personnel responding to the accident.
- ✓ It is very costly to respond to and repairing natural gas line hits.
- ✓ Line hits can slow down a project because of the repair time.
- ✓ For free utility locate call **811**.

If you accidentally hit or nick a gas line:

- **TURN OFF** engines and immediately relocate all personnel to a gas free environment.
- **CALL** the FNG office at 452-7111.
- **DO NOT** attempt to kink or repair the damaged gas pipe.
- Please call even if you there is no apparent leak. A small nick, gouge or stress to the pipe or locate wire may cause a leak or problems later.

How to identify FNG gas pipe:

- Black HDPE (plastic) with yellow stripe,
- Varies in depth of bury, and
- May or may not have caution tape.

ALWAYS CALL BEFORE YOU DIG!
Call 48 hours before underground activity.
